



Medicare Advantage enrollees are

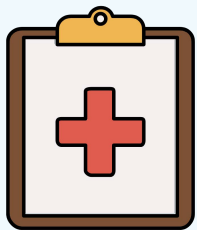

Roughly half of Medicare Advantage live on annual incomes of

less than \$24,500



20% of Medicare Advantage beneficiaries are

dually eligible

for Medicare and Medicaid



33% of MA Beneficiaries

identify as a racial or ethnic minority, compared to 16% in Traditional Medicare



Since 2013, enrollment in Medicare Advantage has grown

11% and 125%, respectively

among minority and dually-eligible beneficiaries



On average, Medicare Advantage beneficiaries have

4.5 chronic conditions

such as diabetes, hypertension, and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease



42% of Black seniors and

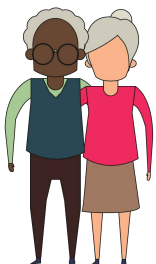
almost half of Latinx seniors
