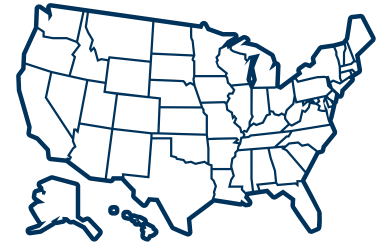


ADMINISTRATION'S MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PROPOSAL COULD LEAD TO HIGHER OUT-OF-POCKET HEALTH CARE COSTS AND FEWER BENEFITS FOR SENIORS



Analysis from Avalere finds that proposed changes from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services in the 2024 Advance Notice could lead to higher out-of-pocket costs and/or fewer benefits for **30 million American seniors and individuals with disabilities** enrolled in Medicare Advantage in 2024 compared to 2023. These estimates are national averages, and the impact on seniors will vary by state.
